Sub: - Agitational Programmes for the settlement of ITS Repatriation issue - req.

Sir,

Consequent upon formation of BSNL, more than 3.5 lakh employees of erstwhile DOT took absorption in BSNL w.e.f 1.10.2000 in deference to the decision of the govt. Group "A" ITS officers working in BSNL on deemed deputation from 01.10.2000 to Oct., 2005 were given four opportunities to get absorbed in BSNL, first in 2005, second in 2008, third in 2011 and last in 2012. Even after repeated four chances to get absorbed, ITS have blatantly defied getting absorbed in BSNL. For the last seven years, BSNL management did not deliberately take even a single initiative to build a Management of its own. Neither BSNL Management nor bureaucracy in DOT has been even remotely concerned about the growth and financial viability of BSNL. For the last one year, entire field units in BSNL are practically dead and no activity is taking place. Instead of working for reviving BSNL, Management is working overtime to somehow retain the non-optee ITS officers ignoring the Govt instructions /orders, at the cost of BSNL.

The meeting of the Forum of BSNL Unions / Associations held at New Delhi on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2012 has expressed its strong protest against the undue delay in the relieving of repatriated ITS officers from BSNL, which is seriously and adversely affecting the services, development and expansion plans and also the future of the BSNL employees. It has been therefore decided to resort to the following agitational programmes for the immediate settlement of the issue mentioned below:

### **DEMAND**

**Immediate relieving of Non-optee ITS officers working in BSNL on deputation.**

**OR**

**All the BSNL Employees (Absorbed/Recruited) should be taken back to Govt Service as in the case of Non-optee ITS.**

**Trade Union action programme:**

- 1) Savingram campaign to Hon'ble Prime Minister, Hon'ble Communications Minister, Cabinet Secretary, Secretary/ DOT and CMD/ BSNL on 11<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> / 13<sup>th</sup> October 2012 demanding immediate relieving of non-optee ITS officers from BSNL. Lunch hour demonstrations will be organised at SSA/Circle/C.O HQ on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2012.
- 2) Mass Dharna on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2012 at SSA/Circle/C.O level with massive participation.
- 3) Parliament March on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2012. At circle and District levels, the March will be organised to the Raj Bhawan and District Collector, respectively.

4) Day long Hunger Strike from 10.00 AM to 06.00 PM at SSA/Circle/C.O levels from 29<sup>th</sup> October for one week.

Indefinite Non-Co-operation from 29<sup>th</sup> October 2012 onwards.

5) If the issues are still not settled, further agitational programmes will be organized to intensify the agitation including Indefinite Strike, the exact date will be announced later.

You are requested to kindly resolve the issues at the earliest.
